Important Tasks to be Completed Before the Closure of Schools for Summer Vacation:

1. Repair and Maintenance of School Property:

- Verify and repair school assets (Fans, Smart TVs, Tabs, Green Chalk Boards, etc.).
- Secure them to avoid theft.
- Document all repairs and take photos.
- Do not disconnect electricity meters.

2. RO Plant:

- Keep power supply on for drinking water system.
- Clean filters before vacation and before reopening.
- Run RO for 10 mins a day before reopening.
- Chlorinate drinking water system.

3. Civil/PCM Materials:

- Store all civil work materials (Tiles, Cement, Furniture, etc.) safely.
- Avoid obstructions and ensure site cleanliness.
- Document all stored material.

4. TEO (Materials and Funds):

- Ensure fund transfer and use under TEO Mechanism.
- Avoid storing materials like cement unsafely.

Ongoing Construction and Safety Measures:

- Construction sites must follow safety protocols.
- Identify risks and ensure safety of students and staff.

5. Safety Guidelines - Child Safety:

- Conduct school inspections with Engineers and Parents Committees.
- Ensure construction areas are barricaded and inaccessible.
- Avoid storage of construction materials in unsafe places.
- Display warning signs and remove electrical risks.
- Prevent water stagnation to avoid mosquito breeding.
- Coordinate with local authorities for necessary actions.
